We have just joined the ranks of countries that offer airport express rail links that provide high-speed travel from central city districts to their international airports in the outskirts. These countries include, the United Kingdom, Norway and Hong Kong and now, we can be proud of our own Express Rail Link (ERL) services that offer speedy and easy travel from the heart of Kuala Lumpur at KL Sentral to our international gateway at Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) as well as various stations in between. No more hassle, no more headaches, no more traffic jams, only a smooth ride to look forward to.

Getting to the Multimedia Super Corridor (MSC), especially to Putrajaya, Cyberjaya and Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA), has been cited as quite a hassle for some, especially for those without personal transportation. But worry no more, as the brand new Express Rail Link (ERL) services has arrived!

Commencing operation in April 2002, the Kuala Lumpur City Air Terminal (KL CAT) allows easy travel for passengers from KL Sentral to KLIA through an integrated rail transit system known as the KLIA Ekspres. KL CAT and KLIA Ekspres joins similar systems operating in London, Hong Kong, Tokyo, Stockholm, Oslo and Milan.

Designed by world-renowned architect who designed the KLIA, Kisho Kurokawa, KL CAT was modelled on the concept of an air terminal within a busy metropolis. KL CAT was designed to provide convenience for air travellers where they can check-in and check-out for both domestic and international flights. The minimum check-in time is two hours but will progressively be reduced.

The non-stop journey between KL CAT and KLIA takes only 28 minutes on the KLIA Ekspres. Operating seven days a week, it departs from both terminals every 15 minutes. The adult fare is at RM35.00 for a single trip.

There is also the Stored Value ticket for frequent travellers and in the future, the Smart Card can also be used.

Fast, reliable and comfortable, KLIA Ekspres is the hassle-free way to start or complete your air travel.

KL Transit

For people working in the MSC area, the KL Transit service will make travelling to work much easier when it commences operation in June 2002.

The KLIA Transit makes three quick intermediate stops along key townships, namely Bandar Tasik Selatan, Putrajaya & Cyberjaya and Salak Tinggi. It integrates with the KTM Komuter and the STAR Light Rail Transit (LRT) at Bandar Tasik Selatan and with the Putrajaya Monorail at Putrajaya's Western Transport Terminal.

KLIA Transit departs every half-an-hour from KL Sentral and KLIA terminals. Total journey time is 36 minutes. Tickets can be purchased through ticket vending machines and ticket counters at the terminals and stations. Fares for this service have yet to be released. However, the indicator price from KL Sentral to Putrajaya & Cyberjaya is approximately RM11.00. The stress-free travel, reduced travelling time, and comfort that you'd be experiencing certainly justifies the price you pay. ●
